

SNOW FOLK PENNY RUG ORNAMENTS

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MATERIALS NEEDED

National Nonwoven Wool Felt

Reets Relish – 8" X 10"

Barnyard Red – 3" x 3"

Fresh Linen- 12" X 12"

Pumpkin Spice - 4" x 4"

Black – 7 " x 7"

Embroidery Floss (Work using 2 strands) Ecru - Black - Antique Gold

Miscellaneous

Iron – Scissors – Card Stock or Index Cards – #2 Lead Pencil - Embroidery Needles – Fusible Webbing (Heat n' Bond) - White Water Soluble Marking Pen – Black Sharpie Marker – Ruler – Cotton Homespun Fabric – 1-1/2" wide by 15" long (bow) – Sprigs of Greens and Berries – Stuffing Hot Glue and Glue Gun – Mica Flakes or Faux Snow – Spray Glue

INSTRUCTIONS

IF YOU WANT THE ORNAMENTS TO APPEAR OLD TEA STAIN EACH FABRIC BEFORE TRACING AND CUTTING DESIGNS. MAKE A HOT CUP OF STRONG TEA. PLACE FABRICS ON A FOLDED OLD TOWEL TO ABSORB MOISTURE. USE AN OLD KITCHEN SPONGE TO DAB TEA OVER EACH PIECE OF FABRIC. THE FABRICS TO DRY . PRESS OUT ANY WRINKLES WITH A DRY IRON SET ON MEDIUM-HIGH.

MAKE CARD STOCK PATTERNS FROM THE DESIGNS ON PATTERNS.

Lay the tea stained batting 2 layers thick and trace the circle shape of the head twice, once for each ornament. Cut out the circles. Blanket stitch the outer edge of each circle using 2 strands of cream embroidery floss. Leave an opening 2" to allow you to stuff.

Iron fusible webbing to the wrong side of the design fabrics. Trace the eyes and mouth on the paper side of the black fabric. Trace the holly to the green – the berries to the red and the noses to the rusty orange. Cut out all design shapes. Remove the paper backing from the designs. Refer to the pattern and photo to place the designs onto each snow folk head with the fusible webbing toward the fabric. Use a dry iron set on medium to fuse the designs to the heads. Stuff each ornament firmly working the stuffing into the edges. Stitch the opening closed. Blanket stitch each nose with antique gold floss. Add black running stitches to each holly leaf – star stitches to the eyes – cross stitches to the mouth pieces and the red berries. Using cream add a small cross stitch to each eye for the high light. Use cream to add a hang cord to the back of each ornament.

FINISHING

Hot glue sprigs of greens and berries to the boy snow folk. Add a bow made of the homespun cotton over the ends of the greenery. Lightly mist each ornament with spray glue and sprinkle mica flakes or faux snow gently to each ornament for high lights.

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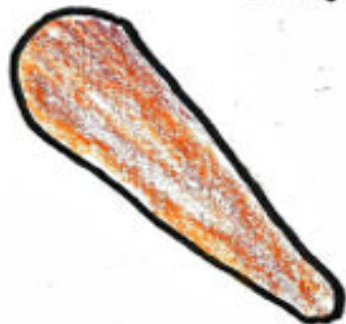

Nose-Cut 1



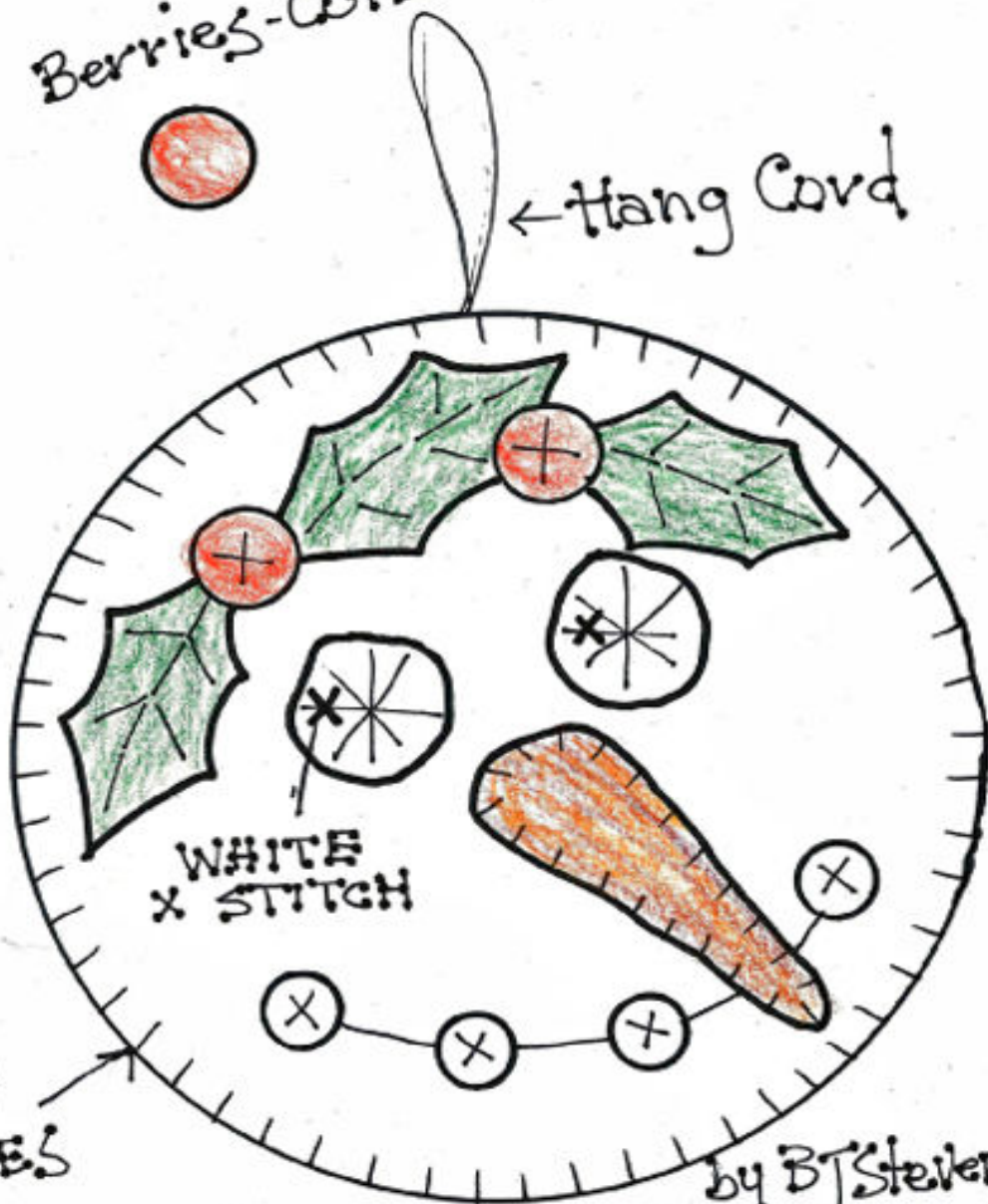
Berries-Cut 2
